

Transition to Legacy Southwest: Update

As of January 1st, management of Castle Hills has transitioned from Bright Realty Management to Legacy Southwest Property Management.

Account balances are now uploaded to Legacy Southwest's platform, CINC Systems - so payments made prior to transition or other outstanding assessments are now reflected in the CINC resident portal.

Community documents, CCR's and forms have also been uploaded, allowing residents to access these documents along with account information through their resident portal.

2025 Annual Assessment: NOW LATE!

IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY PAID YOUR ASSESSMENT:

- The 2025 annual assessment is \$1,360 and invoices were mailed in October 2024
- The annul assessment is due in full on January 1st, every year
- It can be paid through January 31st without penalty
- Past due notices have been sent
- Accounts without a payment made prior to February 1st, accrued interest of 18% per annum for the 31 days in January and a \$50 delinquency fee
- Demand letters are mailed to delinquent accounts in March
- Residents now have the ability to pull their own statements in their portal in CINC Systems.

Account Payment Methods

Residents have a variety of payment methods for the annual assessment, or any other charges that may need to be paid on their accounts.



Below are instructions for each of the available payment methods for Castle Hills.

Pay Online (Credit/Debit Card or ACH)

The Castle Hills Residential Association, Inc. web portal is available through CINC Systems for accessing and updating your information, viewing your account/balances, make online payments, and more.

Visit **Iswpm.cincwebaxis.com** and follow these steps to get started:

- 1. Select **Sign In** at the upper right corner.
- 2. Click **Create Account** at the bottom right.
- 3. Enter your property details into the form.
- 4. Once registration is confirmed, you'll receive an email with a link to set your password.
 *Please allow 24 hours for your registration to be validated by Legacy Southwest.

Please note, there is a processing fee of 3.25% for credit cards, and \$2.99 for echeck.

- Be sure to drip your faucets and open doors to sink pipes to keep them warm during imminent freezing weather conditions.
- Cover all exterior hose bibs and insulate any water lines that run along exterior walls so your water supply will be less likely to freeze.

How Do I Get Amenity Access?

Access to the workout rooms and pools (during pool season with purchase of a pool membership) is with a key-fob.

Key-fobs can be obtained from the Queen Margaret Community Center.

Each estate is allowed a maximum of two (2) active key-fobs. Residents get the first one (1) at no charge. An additional or replacement fob is \$20 check or online payment only.

Resident's must be current on their dues in order to obtain and maintain amenity access.

If you are leasing, we will need your leasing details and the amenity access authorization form completed.

Pool Access

Pool season is April 1st - October 31st, and access requires a key-fob, and the purchase of a pool membership.

Memberships go on sale the last week of March, and can be

purchased at the community center, or processed online.

Sports Fields Reservations

The sports fields are for the use of Castle Hills residents only.

Residents must be current on their HOA dues to reserve a field.

Fifty percent of the rosters must be Castle Hills residents.

The fields are for youth practice. Officiated games and league play are not permitted at any time.

The seasons are as follows:

- **February 10th: Spring Season** (March-April-May)
- May 10th: Summer Season (June-July-August)
- August 10th: Fall Season (September-October-November)
- November 10th: Winter Season (December-January-February)



The fields are for the use of community resident youths only.

If you see anyone using the fields that should not be, please call patrol at 214-274-2057

- -The deadline to have applications submitted is the 10th of the month prior to the start of the season
- -Applications received after these dates will be processed on a space available basis for the current or next upcoming season.
- -Applications received by the deadline date, will have scheduling conflicts resolved using a lottery method.

How Castle Hills Mail Delivery Works


USPS delivers mail/packages to each resident's mailbox at the Sword Bridge Mail Center. The Castle Hills mail staff pulls the mail to deliver to each resident's home the following day. Items such as certified and registered mail requiring a signature will need to be picked up at either: the Colony Post Office (Lewisville residents) or the Carrollton Post Office (Carrollton residents).

Every effort is made to deliver packages the same day they are received. The Castle Hills Mail Center will also hold your mail for vacations and re-deliver to you upon your return home.

If you are expecting a package delivery, please:

- 1. Leave your front porch light on during the evening
- 2. Make sure your address number is visible from the street.

These simple items will assist all mail center personnel to efficiently and accurately deliver your items.



COMPLIANCE CORNER

Replacing Parkway Trees

Properties that have missing, dead, or dying parkway trees have until **April 15th, 2025** to replace them before violations are issued individually.

Many parkway trees were lost during the May 2024 storm, and a grace period through October was given to replace lost trees due to the imminent summer months.

We are well past that grace period, and there are still many missing parkway trees, and unsightly tree stumps in the parkway areas throughout the neighborhood.

Parkway trees are a requirement of the Castle Hills Design Guidelines, and are the responsibility of the owner. These are the trees located

between the street and the sidewalk directly in front of the home, and in some cases, at the side of the home as well if a corner lot.



Replacement parkway trees must be a **minimum of 3** ½ **inch caliper** (**diameter**) **when you measure 12 inches from the base** of the tree; otherwise, it will be too small when mature.

There are specific tree species for each street in Castle Hills.

If you do not know what tree species is on your street, please email

<u>hoa@castlehills.org</u> and we can verify the tree species for you.

All exterior holiday lights and décor should now be removed.

Properties that still have exterior holiday décor visible after this date may be issued a violation notice.

If you receive a violation notice but have take down scheduled, please let your compliance coordinator, Jae, know.





Sugar Cookie Valentine Hearts Recipe

Ingredients

Sugar Cookie Dough

- 1 cup Butter
- 1 cup Granulated Sugar
- 1 Large Egg
- 1 tablespoon Vanilla Extract
- 2 teaspoon Baking Powder
 - 3 cups All-Purpose Flour

Other ingredients

- The Best Buttercream Frosting
- Valentine's Day Sprinkles
- Heart Cookie Cutter Set
- Food Coloring Pink
- Food Coloring Crimson

Instructions

To make the Sugar Cookie dough, cream the softened butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add the egg and vanilla and beat until thoroughly combined. Add the baking powder and mix. Finally the flour, one cup at a time and mix just until combined.

Roll out the cookie dough about 5/8" and use a small Heart Cookie Cutter to cut out the heart-shaped Sugar Cookie Bites.

Bake in an oven preheated to 350 degrees for 5-6 minutes (depending on how thick or thin you rolled the dough). Check on the cookies at the 4-minute mark, because you don't want to over bake them. The edges will be slightly golden when they are ready to come out of the oven.

Allow the cookies to cool completely before you frost them.

Make a batch of our Best Buttercream Frosting Recipe and split it into three portions. Leave one portion white and color the other two pink and red.

Frost the cookie bite hearts.

Sprinkle the top of the frosting with Valentine's Day Sprinkles.
