One-Time Waiver of Certain Delinquent Fees

The Board of the Castle Hills Residential Association and Legacy Southwest Property Management have heard your concerns.

Despite best efforts to inform the community, relay important transition information and changes residents could expect (such as a new payment platform, delinquency process, fees, collections, etc.), the perfect storm of the Annual Assessment Due Date, Management Transition Date and Account Balance Import into the new Platform, CINC Systems, has led the Board to approve a one-time waiver of interest and delinquent fees from delinquent 2025 Annual Assessments and 2024 Special Assessments.

- If you have already brought your Delinquent Accounts current and paid the Interest and Delinquent Fees,
 you will receive a credit on your account for those paid fees.
- If you have already brought you Delinquent Accounts current but did not pay the Interest and Delinquent Fees, you will see a reversal of those fees on your account.

The Collection Fee of \$25 is a Legacy Southwest Property Management fee for processing delinquent accounts and issuing notice of delinquency. This fee will not be waived.








Account Payment Methods

CINC Systems

Pay Online (Credit/Debit Card or ACH)

The Castle Hills Residential Association, Inc. web portal is available through CINC Systems for accessing and updating your information, viewing your account/balances, make online payments, and more.

Visit **Iswpm.cincwebaxis.com** and follow these steps to get started:

- 1. Select **Sign In** at the upper right corner.
- 2. Click **Create Account** at the bottom right.
- Enter your property details into the form.
- 4. Once registration is confirmed, you'll receive an email with a link to set your password. *Please allow 24 hours for your registration to be validated by Legacy Southwest.

Please note, there is a processing fee of 3.25% for credit cards, and \$2.99 for echeck.

SPRING IS IN THE AIR

And So Are Seasonal Allergies!

ALLERGY SEASON AHEAD

March brings warmer weather, longer days—and for many, the return of seasonal allergies. If you find yourself reaching for tissues more often this time of year, you're not alone! Here's what you need to know.

What Causes
Spring Allergies?
Pollen from trees, grass,
and flowers fills the air, triggering sneezing, congestion,
itchy eyes, and sinus pressure.
Windy days can make symptoms
worse by spreading allergens far and
wide. Other common triggers include
mold spores, dust, and pet dander, which
can linger indoors even after winter.

Managing Allergy Symptoms

To reduce exposure, check daily pollen counts and limit outdoor activities when levels are high. Keep windows closed and use air purifiers indoors. After spending time outside, change clothes and shower to remove pollen.

What Can You Do?

Over-the-counter allergy medications, such as antihistamines and decongestants, can pro-vide relief from symptoms. It's also helpful to talk with your doctor for personalized advice and treatment options.

How Do I Get Amenity Access?

Access to the workout rooms and pools (during pool season with purchase of a pool membership) is with a key-fob.

Key-fobs can be obtained from the Queen Margaret Community Center.

Each estate is allowed a maximum of two (2) active key-fobs. Residents get the first one (1) at no charge. An additional or replacement fob is \$20 check or online payment only.

Resident's must be current on their dues in order to obtain and maintain amenity access.

If you are leasing, we will need your leasing details and the amenity access authorization form completed.

Pool Access

Pool season is April 1st - October 31st, and access requires a key-fob, and the purchase of a pool membership.

Memberships go on sale the last week of March, and can be

purchased at the community center, or processed online.

- -Applications received after these dates will be processed on a space available basis for the current or next upcoming season.
- -Applications received by the deadline date, will have scheduling conflicts resolved using a lottery method.



How Castle Hills Mail Delivery Works


USPS delivers mail/packages to each resident's mailbox at the Sword Bridge Mail Center. The Castle Hills mail staff pulls the mail to deliver to each resident's home the following day. Items such as certified and registered mail requiring a signature will need to be picked up at either: the Colony Post Office (Lewisville residents) or the Carrollton Post Office (Carrollton residents).

Every effort is made to deliver packages the same day they are received. The Castle Hills Mail Center will also hold your mail for vacations and re-deliver to you upon your return home.



- 1. Leave your front porch light on during the evening
- 2. Make sure your address number is visible from the street.

These simple items will assist all mail center personnel to efficiently and accurately deliver your items.

COMPLIANCE CORNER Storm Damage & Repair Process

We know there are many of you who had some storm damage and will need to make repairs to your estate.

Below are some quick references regarding the ARC process and storm damage repairs/replacements:

• We lost property trees. Whose responsibility is that and do I need approval to remove and replace them?

Estate trees are a requirement of the community design guidelines and are the responsibility of the property owner; even the parkway trees. You do not need approval to remove damaged trees if you plan to replace them, same for same. If immediate replacement is not possible, we ask you please provide a timeframe of when the tree will be replaced so it can be notated to avoid violation. Should you desire to change the species of your parkway tree or not replant at all, you will need to submit an application.



Deadline to have parkway trees replaced is now October 15th, 2025!

I need to replace my roof—do I need approval?

Yes! You do need approval to replace your roof, however, those applications can be expedited. The committee just needs these three details listed on the application; the **brand**, **style** and **color** of the shingles you are wanting to use (even if it is same as existing).



Part of my fence was blown down—do I need approval to repair a section of it?

No, you do not need approval to repair a section of fence, as long as it matches the remaining/existing fence in materials and stain color.

I need to replace my whole fence—do I need approval?

Yes! If you are replacing your entire fence, you do need approval.

These applications can also be expedited if the committee gets these details provided with the application; copy of the plot plan with indication as to when the second seco



provided with the application; **copy of the plot plan with indication as to where the fence is going** (even if it's the same footpath—just highlight/mark that on the plot plan).

• My neighbor and I share a fence and it needs repair or replacement. How do I go about that?

We encourage neighbors with shared fences to work that out amongst themselves as you both benefit from it. If you come to the conclusion to replace the fence, it will need to be approved.

I did not know I needed approval, and work has already been done. What do I do?

We still recommend you submit an application, even if the work has already been done, just so you have that documented in your property file.

These were the inquiries most asked the week of the storm. Please let us know if you have additional questions specific to your situation and we will be happy to assist you.


